Short-term teams assist GCE Field workers in local children's ministry



Despite incredibly gracious support, GCE Field Workers and Teams are struggling throughout all regions where the ministry is working. Workers incomes have ranged from 52 –78% of their total needs in 2010. Even with these financial challenges, God has done miraculous things in all areas of GCE influence in 2010. Would you consider giving a one-time gift of at least \$300 or a monthly gift of \$25-60 to help support a GCE worker for one month in 2011?

GCE has 28 full-time field workers. Their average living and ministry expenses are \$300-\$700 a month. Due to budget shortages, GCE has only been able to fund about 60% of these costs in 2010. Despite shortages, GCE field workers have continued to labor faithfully. Would you consider pledging support for one GCE worker in 2011? A one-time gift of at least \$300, or a pledge of \$25-60 per month would completely cover the living and ministry expenses of one GCE worker for one month in 2011.

The Fuente de Vida Church in the town of San Marcos Niza experienced exponential growth in 2010 with the assistance of GCE leadership.



The Sotelo Family (Jacob, Raquel, and Natan) are GCE leaders who are being used by the Lord to reach the Tarahumara people of northern Mexico. The Tarahumara are one of the most unreached people groups in all of Mexico.

Proposed GCE Projects in 2011:

- **Getting local AA Chapters in the city of San Lorenzo, Mexico involved in CHE. Members have been receptive to God's Word and a church has been planted by GCE workers.**
- **Continued training of indigenous Tarahumara workers to reach out to their people. There are currently 7 workers being trained.**
- **Continued work and growth in the El Salvadoran city of Quetzaltepeque. Once considered one of the top three cities in the country to gang violence, it is now no longer on that list. CHE workers are making headway!**
- **GCE will be beginning work in Honduras in 15 new communities in 2011.**
- **In Nicaragua, sixteen projects will continue to be supported in rural and urban areas in 2011.**
- **Continued development and construction of the CHE Training Center in 2011.**
