CHE Meso-America Regional Council Meeting Report

This past June, 32 CHE leaders representing thousands of CHE Churches, Training Teams, workers, and prayer warriors met in Quetzaltenango for the Meso-America CHE Regional Council Meeting. Representing five nations (Guatemala, Nicaragua, El Salvador, Honduras, and Mexico), as well as ATM Ministries, Global CHE Network, and WorldVenture, these leaders met to pray, seek the Lord's guidance, and train and equip leadership to effectively reach their home areas for Christ. After three days of prayer, training, teaching, and fellowship, all participants felt drawn nearer to God. Jesus prayed for all of His disciples "that these be one" in order that the world would believe that the Father has sent the Son. Participants walked away feeling energized and refreshed in the Lord to continue the work of the Great Commandment and the Great Commission, and to return to the field prepared to reap the harvest for the Lord Jesus Christ!

But what exactly is CHE Leadership Training, and what was the focus of this recent meeting?

CHE ministry is "Learner Centered". Through a teaching methodology called LePSAS, communities that become part of CHE know that they must take the leadership role and be involved in their own communities. CHE communities know from the start that any outside leadership is provided only to facilitate the CHE process, not to direct it. The concepts of interactive learning, inductive and participatory training, and holistic growth in a village are central to the CHE training theme.



CHE training involves a community-wide problem-solving approach to ministry. Outside leadership does not come in to a new ministry area and present solutions; it is the job of each CHE community to arrive at their own solutions to their own unique challenges.

CHE training is Spirit led and Spirit guided. Before any training is to begin, prayer is the central focus. Seeking the Lord's wisdom and asking for His guidance throughout the entire training process is a cornerstone and a must for all CHE ministry work. "For the upright will live in the land, and the blameless will remain in it." (Prov. 2:21)

CHE training uses a hands-on, tangible approach to the application of its ministry concepts at all times. All CHE participants learn through guided simulations, hands-on practice, and thought provoking games and activities over the course of multiple visits to regions participating in CHE. The goal of CHE is to train and equip local leadership to become self-sustaining bodies of ministry. Each leader is encouraged to explore and encounter all that God has for them, and to seek out and understand the unique giftings He has anointed them with. Participants are then encouraged to seek and understand how their specific giftings fit into the local body of ministry to which they belong. The ultimate goal is to propagate the Gospel and all of the abundant life that the Lord has in store for all who seek Him.



A GCE Testimony

Enrique and Santa Puac are a couple who live in the village of Paul among the Quiche people of Guatemala. Through home visits from local CHE volunteers, the Puac's have left their life of idolatry and traditional rural belief and have come to receive Christ as Lord and to begin a new life in Jesus. They especially are giving the Lord praise for the fact that their young daughter will now grow up knowing the Lord. They recently invited CHE workers to their home for a special celebratory meal, and to share their testimony of what the Lord has done.
